PLANS FINALIZED FOR UPCOMING ENERGY FAIR

Meredith, New Hampshire- Details for the upcoming Lakes Region Energy Fair have been announced. The event, scheduled for Saturday, October, 18, 2014 at the Inter-Lakes High School, will feature over 25 local vendors showcasing their products, expertise and services. According to Ken Colburn of the Meredith Energy Committee, a co-sponsor of the event, “The vendors and exhibitors lineup looks great. Doors open at 9:30 AM and the event runs until 2:00 PM allowing people to visit the fair whenever it is convenient to stop by.”

In addition to a gym full of vendors, fair organizers have scheduled 16 interesting presentations on a wide range of relevant energy topics including home weatherization, wood energy options, residential solar, hot water alternatives, local energy projects, energy grants & rebates, living off the grid and NH’s energy future. “We have a host of local and state experts to share lots of great information and perspective,” added Chris Johnson of the Center Harbor Energy Committee. The 45 minute sessions are informal and will provide plenty of time to have your questions answered. Attendees can visit the vendors, attend a presentation or two, or do a little of both as your day permits. Over \$4,000 worth of energy-related door prizes will be given away throughout the event during scheduled session breaks. Door prizes include a number of home energy audits, valuable gift cards and energy-related products. There is no charge to attend and light refreshments will be available.

“Saving energy saves you money. That’s the bottom line”, concluded Colburn, “...and it’s good for the environment and local economy as well.”
