


Go take a hike! – In Meredith

<p>*Directions: Rte. 3 south to Rte. 104 west. Left on Corliss Hill Road to the end. Right on Meredith Center Road to Chemung Road (on left). Follow Chemung Road to parking area.</p> <p>-700+ acres -7 miles of trails -Over 300 ‘ elevation gains -Views of lakes & mountains</p>	<p>*Directions: Rte 25 east to Quarry Road. Follow Quarry Road to the parking area.</p> <p>-600 acres -View Page Pond, mill site, quarry, quarry shop -Over 7 miles of trail -Varying terrain</p>	<p>*Directions: Rte. 25 west to Jenness Hill Road on left. Follow Jenness Hill Road to parking area on left.</p> <p>-185 acres -Over 5 miles of trail - Walking distance from Meredith Village and the Community Center</p>	<p>*Directions: Rte 3 south to round-about, take first right on to Parade Road (Rte. 106). Follow to parking area on right.</p> <p>-190 acres -Interpretive trail system -Over 3 miles of trail -Varying terrain</p>
