Chairman Phil Mercer immediately turned over the meeting to Jacquie Colburn. She led a presentation to the Planning Board and Commission on the status and accomplishments of the Natural Resource Inventory. She was aided in this presentation by Town Planner and Rick Van de Poll. Many different maps were shown and explained. Each map showed a different natural resource, its size and location. It was explained that by computer these different maps could be layered on top of each other. The result would show areas where two or more resources existed. The Committee had developed a number of criterion to evaluate different areas. Such a ranking could be used to determine those areas most deserving of preservation or on the other hand those area which best lend themselves to development. Such a tool can be of immense value in the planning of the future growth of Meredith.
