

Handicapped Access to Trails in Meredith Town Forests -

There are three Meredith Town Forests which have recreational trails: Hamlin-Eames, Meredith Community Forest and Page Pond and Forest. Trails are periodically maintained by the all-volunteer town Conservation Commission and maps are available elsewhere on this page.

None of our forest trails are designed for handicapped access. Limitations include steep terrain, unbridged or narrow-bridged water crossings, too-rocky or too-soft surfaces, fallen trees, and open ledges and water margins which are without barriers. Maps indicate trails which are open to snowmobiles under conditions of adequate snow cover. Other than prudent snowmobile use, our town forest trails are unsafe for handicapped mobility devices of any kind.
