ABOUT THIS MAP

Wetlands were derived from National Wetland Inventory maps, NRCS hydric soils maps, and 1998 digital aerial photography (DOQ's). Final map adjustment of prime wetlands were made in the field using a Garmin 12 XL GPS unit. Precision of GPS points was 3.4 to 7.7 m. Roughly 50% of all prime wetland boundaries were field surveyed, based on property access permission.
